- Blight Home Attack program
  - Reviewed suggested first-class letter to immediate homeowners near targeted "Blight Home(s)"
  - Board showed interest
  - Will continue discussion at September meeting
- Green Space
  - o Our "Park" Committee. Meeting with Matt McCoy and Joe Gatto and others
  - O Ben Page did not seem on board with WHNA desire to proceed on neighborhood park goal
  - Subsequent communications Buz Brenton, Ben Page, and Dave
    - Buz is in agreeance with Ben Page that the city should not put in any money for a small neighborhood park.

      This should not be public money. His thought is if neighbors are not willing to put in \$100/year for two years then they are not really interested in having a park.
  - Board showed interest in having Buz come speak at one of our meeting regarding park, his participation and what he wants from the neighborhood
